QUARTZ / MARBLE

Material Properties

Gloster quartz (Cloud coffee tables) offers the natural beauty of quartz with up to six times the strength and durability of granite. Approximately 93% of the material is comprised from natural quartz crystals, one of nature's hardest materials. The quartz is combined with special resins and pigments to create a beautiful and strong surface that is highly scratch and impact resistant. Gloster quartz is also intrinsically nonporous, preventing unwelcome germs, bacteria and mildew. Gloster quartz does not require sealing, conditioning or polishing.

Marble (Grid coffee table) is a softer and more porous material than quartz. This makes it more susceptible to scratches, pitting and stains. Marble is also quite porous and can be easily etched by acids, so some care and common sense should be used when using and maintaining.

Cleaning

To keep the surface of Quartz and Marble clean, regularly wipe with a clean microfibre cloth and warm, diluted, neutral detergent. Alternatively a pH balanced, proprietary stone cleaner can be used. Do not use steel wool, or other harsh abrasives as these will scratch and dull the surface.

Spillages of wine, coffee, ketchup, oils and acidic substances such as vinegar and citrus fruits should be wiped clean immediately as these can cause minor discolouration (especially on light colour Quartz). For any stubborn stains, mix talcum powder with water to create a paste, apply to the stain, let the paste dry out then remove with clean water.

We recommend that Marble is sealed regularly using a proprietary marble sealer to prevent stains and damage. Reseal when water fails to bead up when splashed on the surface.
